In addition the board voted on the inclusion of a post card in the Self Starter – be on the lookout for the card – it will be in a bright color. This will give you an option to get the International Directory in the mail or opt out and access the data online only. Prior to the meeting I surveyed our Peach State members and it was clear than many of you don't use the directory at all and preferred the on-line version. By reducing the printed directories we will be able to save on printing and mailing costs.

Lauren Schweitzer has resigned her position as National Registrar effective the 2018 GN. The registrations for the GN and car entries in the future will be handled through Nancy and Mike Book, our office managers in Columbus, Ohio. The CLC now has an active membership of 6741 members, which is a decrease of 122 members from the end of March when we had our GN Board Meeting in Las Vegas! Gary Fisher and I are Co-Chairs of the Awards Committee. We once again received funding from Cadillac for the 2017, 2018 and 2019 class awards. This is a very significant contribution to our club. Cadillac also supports the Self Starter with their advertisements and their sponsorship of the Grand National Welcome Reception. Chris Hamann manages the car awards hardware and oversees all award construction in conjunction with the vendors. Thank you Chris, this is one heck of a task. And we invested in the future. We will now join **YOURMEMBERSHIP**, an integrated solution for managing members, events, communications and automating workflows. The Oldsmobile Club has already joined this new technology and the Oldsmobile President was at our board meeting talking about the advantages. Despite the high up-front costs the motion was passed and we will now advance to more unified automation. It will also be user-friendly for our members.

Steve Stewart was not able to attend our meeting but reported that all was going well with the Self Starter and they have once again received the Golden Quill Award in 2016. This tradition goes back to 2004. Congratulations, a fantastic job! Tim Coy is our Art Director and Maggi Stewart is the Copy Editor.

Melissa Perry also missed the board meeting. She reported that sales were in excess of \$10,000 for the 2017 International Membership Directory. Overall, our advertising sales are down by nearly \$6,000.00.

The regional vice presidents made their reports and a few regions are not doing as well as we are. On the bright side, members in South Florida want to start a new region. It would cover the Miami/Ft. Lauderdale area. The CLC Suncoast Region is 250 miles northwest. They will start paperwork to establish a provisional region.

The treasurers report showed reduced incomes due to lack of members and advertising revenues and higher costs due to increased costs and increased technology expenses.
